Dear Faithful Friends and Supporters, Greetings in our Beloved Saviour's Name! We trust that all is well with you. I am reading the Book of Romans as I meditate through the entire bible. I thought of each of you as I read 1:10, "Making request, if by any means now at length I (we) might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you". We wish this for our 13 supporting churches. We are already scheduled with ten of you and hope to schedule with the other three. We are so very thankful to our Father for these churches who have befriended, encouraged, and loved us over the years demonstrated through prayers and financial support. We also rejoice in the ten individuals who partner with us with love, care, friendship, prayer and support. We say to you, with Paul in Rom. 1:11,12, " For I (we) long to see you...that I (we) may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me (us)."

We have had a busy, fruitful ministry since our summer letter. Our stateside meetings are always a joy and blessing. We are so wonderfully blessed to work side by side with such choice pastors and churches....a remnant of those who "Earnestly contend for the faith once delivered."

Our latest foreign ministry encompassed the last two weeks of August and first week of September. It was my first time to preach in the country of South Africa and the 30th country outside of the USA to declare our Lord's saving Gospel.

Grace stayed back in Ohio to get Jonathan settled into a christian school for his senior year of high school (can you believe he is in 12th grade?...some of you are shaking your head this very moment!). We are transitioning him from home school to the bible college classroom. He would like to attend Maranatha Baptist University next fall to participate in their ROTC program.

I was so blessed to work with Missionary Lee Peterson and his sweet family during my time in Sedgfield, South Africa. I was scheduled to preach in three different churches and enjoyed the South African believers in each church. It is VERY difficult to get lost people into such meetings. I know of only two unsaved individuals who attended during my whole time. One was a 16 year old grandson of one of the members. I actively engaged him in witness after the service, but, alas, he was "not ready". I did perceive great movement of the Spirit in the hearts and lives of the Saints! We are invited back there again in 2017. This time with my wife!

My next foreign venture is next month (October-November) to the twin Island nation of Trinidad and Tobago. I have had numerous times of ministry here since 1990. I so look forward as Paul said in Rom. 1:13, "I purposed to come unto you, that I might have some fruit among you."

This December (28) we will travel again to Israel and continue touring there until January 9. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6). We love to support

Israel in this way of bringing Servants of God to His Land. Let us know if you would like to be put on our "interested list" for our next tour.

Throughout this fall, we will also minister in the states of SC (presently), FL, WI, MN, NV, MD, SD, and OK. Please pray for safety and fruitfulness in all our domestic and foreign ministries!
