CANCELLATIONS

This has been the fluid situation in our schedule for 2020 and 2021. ALL foreign meetings scheduled within these two years has canceled. We know that it is our foreign ministry that motivated most of you to support us; so, again, thank you for understanding our predicament. We have rescheduled all of these foreign meetings for 2022 and 2023. We can only pray that in God’s sovereignty we will be able to fulfill them. PLEASE pray that the COVID restrictions will be lifted worldwide.

CALIBRATIONS

We have re-calibrated our 2021 schedule to replace foreign cancellations. We have added more domestic meetings and a couple more “interim pastorates”. As we did last year, we serve churches that are currently without a pastor. We fill the pulpit, administrate, witness and counsel as needed.
