We are back at Northfield, MA, because we had to cancel 6 weeks of meetings in Hungary, Romania and France. It was the general consensus of our European brethren to postpone these meetings. COVID restrictions there limit the amount of people that can assemble. I was also having physical issues that necessitated the cancellations. An MRI revealed no blockage or cancer in the bladder. I am still under a Urologist's care. But things look good! Praise God!

Northfield Baptist Church is still without a pastor and have been seeking one for the past two and a half years. It has been very difficult to find a New England man ready to come to this small church (the church use to run 100, last year was 30, this year it is down to 15 people- some have left because of being this long without a pastor.) Other men from other parts of our country who were contacted seem to not be willing to consider a church in New England. The church has a beautiful colonial style building that will seat 300 and a lovely four bedroom parsonage right next door. The work here is very difficult but not impossible to see growth. We are ministering to a city of 3,000 souls that are mostly liberal left Catholic democrats. Can God's Light pierce through this darkness? We believe so but it will be a slow, patient process- need a "plodder".

Pray for our six weeks of ministry here. When we depart, we will return to the Revival trail in NY state, OH and MN.

Thanks for your prayers for us and for the Northfield Baptist Church. God bless you all as you labor patiently with us in the ministry at home, and, prayerfully abroad.
